## *From the Desk of Mike Schwab—Village President*

Happy New Year!

I hope you had a great holiday season!

A few things happened just before the close of the year that I want to bring you up to date on.

On December 3, 2015, Circuit Court Judge Martens issued a ruling in the lawsuit brought against the Village of Jackson by the Town of Jackson and a group called "Jackson Town Residents Against Annexation." While Judge Martens ruled that the agreement the Village and Town entered into in 1999 and amended in 2005 and 2008 is enforceable, a few questions are still outstanding.

Judge Martens set a date of January 12 to issue another ruling on outstanding items, but in the meantime Village Staff is working with Town Officials to work out the details and ensure that necessary services are provided in a professional and timely manner.

We look forward to learning the details of the additional information Judge Martens will provide on January 12, and to welcoming the new village residents when the changes become effective.

## Property Tax Payments

For property owners who have not yet paid their 2015 property taxes, the first installment must be paid to the Village of Jackson Treasurer on or before January 31 (Mailing Address: Village of Jackson Treasurer, PO Box 637, Jackson, WI 53037.) Please remember to enclose the payment stub for the first installment with your payment. If you would like a receipt remember to enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope.

The second installment must be paid to the County Treasurer on or before July 31 (Address: Washington County Treasurer, Jane Merten, 432 E Washington St, PO Box 1986, West Bend, WI 53095.) Please remember to enclose the payment stub for the second installment with your payment. If you would like a receipt remember to enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope.
