

RESOLUTION #15-19

UTILIZING THE WASHINGTON COUNTY
SITE REDEVELOPMENT GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Washington County has been proactively working to evaluate and assess sites in need of redevelopment or "brownfield" sites; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, Washington County, as the Lead Coalition Member, formed a Coalition of Partners with the City of Hartford, City of West Bend, Village of Jackson, Village of Richfield, and Village of Slinger to apply for a U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Brownfield Coalition Assessment Grant for Hazardous Substance and Petroleum Brownfields; and

WHEREAS, on May 28, 2014, the USEPA announced that Washington County was successful in securing a Countywide Coalition Brownfield Assessment Grant totaling \$600,000; and

WHEREAS, a Site Redevelopment Steering Committee (SRC) was formed to provide input into grant implementation, oversight, and guidance during all phases of the Site Redevelopment Program; and

WHEREAS, the SRC includes leaders from local government, including the Coalition Partners and the business community; and

WHEREAS, Washington County has allotted an amount of up to \$40,000 per Coalition Partner to facilitate assessment and planning for redevelopment opportunities in designated areas of the respective communities; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Board of the Village of Jackson, Wisconsin hereby authorizes Staff to work with program consultants including Stantec Consulting Services, Inc., Vandewalle & Associates, and Economic Development Washington County to develop area selections and prioritize sites for potential reuse and redevelopment within the Village of Jackson; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village Board authorizes the Administrator to sign the necessary documents to utilize a portion of the Village's allotted funds as approved by Washington County.
