A private well permit may be granted to a well owner to operate a well for a period of three years if the following requirements are met:

- 1) The well has passed an installation that meets the requirements of Chapter NR 812, Wisconsin Administrative Code, and a well constructor's report is on file with the Department of Natural Resources (DNR), or certification of the acceptability of the well has been granted by DNR.
- 2) The well has passed an inspection by a DNR licensed well inspector and DNR form 3300-221, Wisconsin Well and Pressure System Inspection Form, is on file with the Village Engineer. The inspection form on file shall be no greater than ten years old.
- 3) The well has a history of producing safe water and presently produces bacteriological safe water as evidenced by a sample submitted to a state certified laboratory for microbial analysis.
- 4) No physical connection exists between the piping of the public water system and the private well.
- 5) The proposed use of the well can be justified as being necessary in addition to water provided by the public water system.

The undersigned hereby agrees to perform the work according to Chapter NR 812, Wisconsin Administrative Code. The applicant also agrees to repair or replace any work that does not conform to said Code.
