A RESOLUTION HONORING POLICE CHIEF JED DOLNICK FOR HIS YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON

WHEREAS, Jed Dolnick first served the Jackson Police Department as its interim chief in 1995, during a time of crisis for the department, to prepare a smooth transition for the successor chief; and

WHEREAS, following the retirement of that chief; in February of 2001, the Village Board appointed Jed Dolnick to be the next full-time chief; and

WHEREAS, in 2010, under the leadership of Chief Jed Dolnick, the Jackson Police Department was granted accreditation by the Wisconsin Law Enforcement Accreditation Group (WILEAG); the first agency in Washington County, and the smallest in Wisconsin to earn accreditation; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the Village of Jackson have benefited from the professional efforts and performance of Chief Jed Dolnick; and

WHEREAS, his dedication has helped make the Village of Jackson a better place to live and work;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board and the employees and citizens of the Village of Jackson, express their appreciation for his contributions, his tenure in public service, and his dedication to the Jackson community, and congratulate him on his forthcoming retirement.
