Subject: Weekly Update



Police Department

We provided a traffic safety demonstration to the AARP Safe Driving Class at the Jackson Area Community Center this week.

Officer Grant Demaa is in his final phase of field training. He is scheduled to be certified for solo patrol starting on September 23rd.

The squad camera DVR for Squad #1 has failed. It was sent to the factory for repair. This is the second DVR to fail this year.

The Village continues to experience vandalism in Jackson Park. Over the weekend a garbage can was set on fire. We will be providing extra patrol as we are able, but we ask anyone that sees anything suspicious or has any information to contact the JPD.

This week is National Suicide Prevention Week. There are many people whose lives have been impacted by suicide in one way, shape, or form. There are free resources available for anyone struggling, and many provide services anonymously (the only exception is if you or someone else is in imminent danger). Asking for help is not a sign of weakness; it's a sign of strength in acknowledging that sometimes we need a helping hand. The National Suicide Prevention Lifeline is available 24 hours a day at 800- 273-8255.

Fire Department

This week, the Jackson Fire Department stayed busy with nineteen EMS and seven fire calls, including three Germantown structure fires in three days, a motorcycle accident, car accident, trash can fire at Jackson Park, and a brush fire.

Monday evening, ten of our firefighters began an Aerial Operator state certification class, taught at our station by instructors from Moraine Park Technical College. The class is also open to outside departments with a total of twenty enrolled. It is an excellent opportunity to learn and work together with our mutual aid departments. Monday's training included completing four different fire evolutions involving vehicle fires. Thank you to Jackson Auto for donating two vehicles for us to burn (practice on.)

Two new paid-on-call firefighters have been hired in the last two weeks. Welcome to Clay Allen and Jordan Laboy. Jordan comes with a Firefighter 1 state certification and is already licensed as an EMT.

On Tuesday, preventive maintenance recommended by the manufacturer, after the initial break-in period, was performed on the new truck's aerial ladder. Ladder slides were greased and inspected, and the cables were adjusted. Wednesday, factory representatives installed some software updates on the truck.

This week, EMS protocols were edited, locations on the ambulance for paramedic level equipment were confirmed, scheduling of school visits for fire prevention week were completed, several minor repairs were completed on the vehicles, all air monitoring equipment was calibrated, and work on the design of the new building continued.

Joint Parks and Recreation

The 4k, Head Start, and Tot Time programs began this week without any problems.

All foundation work for the apartment development on Rosewood Lane will be completed by the end of the week. The first rough inspection is slated for December.

Occupancy inspection was completed for KD Automation on Cedar Park Court. Their initial lease is only for eighteen months. This will be coming before the Plan Commission in the coming months.


